- 1 An email and/or note has been received from the Owner that indicates there will be no change in the 2016/17 Fees versus the 2015/16 Fees, therefore, the change is 0%.
 - 2 An email and/or note has been received from the Owner confirming an increase by CPI or less than CPI. Calendar Year 2015 All-Items CPI for Ontario is 1.2%.
 - 3 No reply was received from the Owner. When no reply is received, there is no change in the Fees from one year to the next. The 2016/17 Fees will equal the 2015/16 Fees, therefore, the change is 0%.
 - 4 The MSc E Health Internship Fee will remain the same as in 2015/16, however, for 2016/17 it will be applied at a cost of \$750 for each of the two, four-month terms, instead of \$1500 over one term. This was approved by the Fees Committee in October 2015.
 - 5 A pricing strategy was approved in the 2014/15 budget implementing a 5% annual increase to the Basic meal plan for 3 years. This is the final year of the approved pricing strategy. The lowest meal plans in both categories have been eliminated therefore Optional Meal Plan 1 becomes the Mandatory Meal Plan.
 - 6 HSR Graduate and Undergraduate fees from Public Works: Transit Division.
 - 7 The Engineers Without Borders increased their fees by CPI, and then round up to the nearest full cent. Because their fees are so low, rounding up to the nearest cent results in an increase of 4%. This however, only represents a total increase of 1 cent.
 - 8 The E-Thesis fee is being removed to eliminate an additional cost to students at the end of their program.
 - 9 The Child Life Studies program is ending and a new graduate program starting up, therefore the admission and deposit fees for this program are no longer necessary.
 - 10 Graduate nursing admission deposit is being removed as the program decided it was no longer necessary.
 - 11 The Biomedical Discovery and Commercialization (BDC) Society is a new society. The fees for these students were previously collected as part of the Bachelor of Health Science Society (BHSS), however, as the BDC is a separate program, they requested having their own society. The forming of their society was supported by the Faculty of Health Science and approved by the AVP (Students & Learning) & Dean of Students. The fee is the same as the students were being charged when they were part of the BHSS.
 - 12 M.Sc. in Child Life and Pediatric Psychosocial Care is a new program. The fees for this program were approved at a previous Fees Committee meeting.
 - 13 All Housing and Conference Service fee adjustments have proceeded through the appropriate consultation and approval bodies for consultation/support (HCS Consultation Committees, Senate Sub Committee on Student Affairs, Ancillary Budget Process, etc).
 - 14 The Residence Agreement/Contract (which includes the new HCS Admin Fees [Room Change and Late Documents Fees]) and the Residence Code of Conduct have been approved by the Committee on Student Affairs and by the Senate.
 - 15 These Housing and Conference Service Fees have been removed.

- 16 The DeGroot Commerce Society held a vote at their Annual General Assembly to increase their Society Fee by \$7.50. The increase was successfully voted through, as the meeting had quorum (over 2% of membership) and 96% of votes were in favour of the increase.
- 17 The Late Enrollment Fee has become obsolete with the implementation of Mosaic and will be removed. An adjustment to the Late Payment Fee has been made to make it more consistent with other similar sized universities.
- 18 The fee for the option to use a credit card for payment of student accounts has decreased due to a reduction in fees charged by the credit card companies.
- 19 The MBA Health Insurance is no longer being managed by the GSA. The MBA's now have an agreement with the MSU for both Health and Dental Insurance. The MSU will be charging a \$30 non-refundable fee for this service.
- 20 The MSU Health and Dental for Midwifery and Medicine increased by 1%.
- 21 The Graduate Students Association (GSA) held a referendum from April 28th to 30th, 2016 asking two questions:
- 1) Do they want to pay the same rate as the undergrads (\$33.95 per term) and access the same services as undergrads do in the Student Wellness Centre?
 - a. if yes their fee will increase by \$23.86
 - b. if no, \$10.09 of their fee will continue to be allocated to the Student Wellness Centre for basic medical services and access to the health education unit
 - 2) Do they want to pay \$17.50 per term in order to support career services provided by the School of Graduate Studies?
 - a. if yes, their fee will increase by \$17.50.
 - b. if no, there will be no additional fee, and this service will be eliminated.
- The students voted 'no' to both questions, therefore, their fees for both the Student Wellness Centre and the career services provided by the School of Graduate Studies will increase by CPI only.
- 22 Modified Program Fee is composed of the following fees: Athletics & Recreation Activity Fee, Administrative Services Fees, Student Services Fee and Campus Health Fees. On campus students are charged 100% of these fees and off campus/online students are charged 60% of these fees. There appears to be a slight increase in this fee of greater than CPI, however, this reflects the fact that there was an oversight in a previous year when updating this fee. While the components that make up this fee were increased by CPI, this fee was not updated accordingly.
- 23 The MERG Application Fee is an application fee for the new MERG Certificate program.
- 24 Effective May 11, 2016, the University withdrew the Inter-Residence Council's (IRC) status as a recognized student organization. For the academic year 2016-17 and going forward, the IRC's fee will be collected and administered by the University for the benefit of the students in residence. The fee will be called the Residence Life Activity Fee.
- 25 Bunk and Loft Room with Access to Single User Washroom was added in response to help accommodate the high volume of students requesting residence.
- 26 The MBA Business Employment Service Fee and the MBA Co-op Placement Fee changes their names respectively to the Career and Professional Development Fee and the MBA Co-op Program Fee. There was no change in the amount or purpose of the fees. The name change was intended solely to clarify the purpose of the fees.
